## INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS MIRROR BLANKING PLATES

- **MODEL:** SUZUKI SV1000 03-07
- **PRODUCT CODE:** 000201



### 1. PRODUCT DESCRIPTION

- Mirror blanking plates are designed to cover the mounting points of motorcycle mirrors when they are removed or no longer required.
- They offer a clean, professional finish, protect exposed areas from dirt and damage, and enhance the overall look of the motorcycle by giving it a sleeker, more streamlined appearance.

### 2. SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

- Make sure the motorcycle is parked and the ignition is off. ⚠
- Wear gloves to protect your hands. ⚠
- Do not ride the motorcycle until installation is fully complete and secure. ⚠

### 3. TOOLS REQUIRED

- Cleaning cloth
- Allen key 2,5mm

### 4. KIT CONTENTS

- 2x Mirror blanking plates(left and right)
- 4x M6 screws



### 5. INSTALLATION STEPS

- Step 1: Park the motorcycle on level ground with the ignition off. ⚠
- Step 2: Remove the existing mirrors if installed.
- Step 3: Clean the mirror base area thoroughly to remove any dirt or grease.
- Step 4: Align the mirror blanking plate over the mounting holes.



Step 5: Secure the plate using the screws provided.



Step 6: Repeat the process for the other side.

Step 7: Double-check both plates to ensure they are tightly secured.



## 6. AFTER INSTALLATION

- Confirm both plates are firmly secured.
- Check for any gaps or loose fittings.
- Keep this manual for future use.
